Medications: be aware of their indications, as well as side effects and precautions in physiotherapy.

- 1. Insulin
- 2. Analgesics (Ex : dilaudid, oxycodone)
- 3. Neuropathic analgesic (Ex : lyrica, neurontin)
- 4. Beta blockers (Ex : metoprolol, sotalol)
- 5. Anticoagulant (Ex: heparin, coumadin)
- 6. Diuretics (Ex: Lasix)
- 7. Anti-depressant/Anti-psychotic

Assessment/Treatment:

- 1. Manually taking vitals/monitoring vitals
- 2. Cardioresp assessment: auscultation, cough, if chest physio needed
- 3. Wheelchair/sliding board transfers
- 4. Limb shaping/residual limb wrapping
- 5. Amputee mobility training/pre-prosthetic training
- 6. Neuro Exam
